Vijay Sai is a master of all trades, says CBI

The CBI on Monday described Jagati Publi-cations' vice-chairman, V. Vijay Sai Reddy, as "an intelligent person who has

donned several hats".

The CBI special court hearing Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy's disproportionate assets case was told by senior counsel for the CBI, Mr B. Ravindranath, that all the financial transactions of Mr Jagan Mohan Reddy were handled by Mr Vijay Sai Reddy alone.

The CBI made the comment on Mr Vijay Sai multi-tasking Reddy's skills in response to the defence counsel, Mr Susheel Kumar's argument that Mr Vijay Šai Reddy was just a chartered accountant and "comes into the picture only after the offence had taken place and was not in any way related to the *quid pro* quo favours.

In support of its argument that Mr Vijay Sai Reddy is a public servant and attracts Section 409 of the Indian Penal Code

The investigating agency alleged that Mr Vijay Sai Reddy pumped in about ₹105 crore into Sandur Power and the source of the money was being investigated. "About ₹23 crore was routed using forged DDs of various denominations and the money was routed through the accounts of Mr Vijay Sai Reddy's daughter. The money was routed to Sandur Power owned by Jagan through Kealawn Technology Ltd owned by Mr Vijay Sai Reddy's wife."

The CBI said it is not true that it was yet to identify any public servants involved in the case as alleged by the defence. 'We have identified a large number of public servants," the CBI said.

IIIT-HYDERABAD STUDY Big quake may bring down Jama Masjid domes

SYED AKBAR | DC HYDERABAD, MARCH 5 At 4.9 on Richter scale, Monday afternoon's earthquake in the National Capital Region and surrounding parts of North India may have been 'mild'

but a tremor of a bigger magnitude will seriously imposing minarets and domes of the historic Jama Masjid in Delhi, according to experts. In the first-ever earthquake model for Jama Masjid, India's biggest

high-risk seismic Zone IV. Mr Prasanna Kumar, an IIIT-H student, conducted the unique study to scrutinise the structure's health. Conducted under the guidance of assistant professor Dr D. Neelima Satvam, the study has developed a threedimensional numerical model of Jama Masjid by



taking into account actual material properties. The study assessed the vulnerability of the structure by considering site-specific properties. The peak ground acceleration at the surface has been estimated using finite fault simulation technique and dynamic analysis was done considering the 2001 Bhuj earthquake (7.7 magnitude)

The effects of local soil were also considered and detailed soil structure interaction analysis was carried out. The IIIT-H team also found that stress concentration is more near the top and base of the minarets. It is more on the left edge of the middle dome and on the left edges

of two small domes. In the model plan, area of

three huge gates, four towers and two 40-metre minarets constructed of red sandstone and white marble. The structure's roof is covered with three domes with alternate stripes of black and white marble, with the topmost parts in gold. Two minarets, 130 feet (41 m) high and comprising 130 longitudinally steps, striped with white marble
